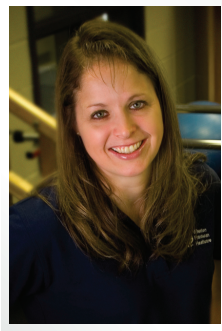

## Physical Therapy

Physical therapy helps individuals, whose ability to move and function in daily life has been impaired, to restore, enhance and/or maintain strength and mobility. With physical therapy people are often able to lead a more active and independent lifestyle. Information that may help prevent further injury is also shared.

## Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapy is utilized to improve or restore independent living skills needed for functioning at home, work or school.

Individuals learn ways to perform and manage every day tasks so they can reach their highest level of independence. Patients learn to use adaptive equipment and new ways to perform daily living skills to help them at home, work or school and to enjoy leisure activities and hobbies.

The Occupational Therapists at Mercy Hospital are ASTYM certified and perform hand therapy which includes any problems of the elbow, forearm, wrist and hand.

Conditions treated may include:

- Carpal Tunnel Syndrome
- Lateral/Medial Epicondylitis
- Overuse Syndrome
- Wrist and Finger Fractures
- Trigger Finger
- Mallet Finger
- Sprains/Strains
- Traumatic Injury/Amputations
- Gamekeeper's Thumb
- Burns
- Lymphedema
- Developmental Disabilities

## Speech Language Pathology

Speech and Language services assist people who may have difficulties with communication, reasoning, swallowing or hearing. Speech-Language Pathologists work to improve or maintain one's safety and communication abilities by focusing on :

- Verbal and Written Expression
- Auditory Comprehension
- Reading Comprehension
- Cognition/Dementia Management
- Dysarthria (poor vocal volume, slurred speech)
- Apraxia (inability to form words)
- Aural Rehabilitation (strategies for hearing impaired)
- Swallowing/Eating Difficulties
- Stuttering/Stammering
- Child Speech & Language
- Child Eating/Swallowing Deficits (oral defensiveness)
